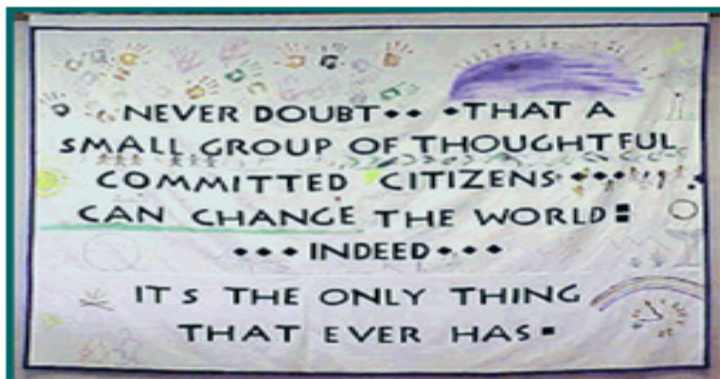
MANY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES EXIST!
