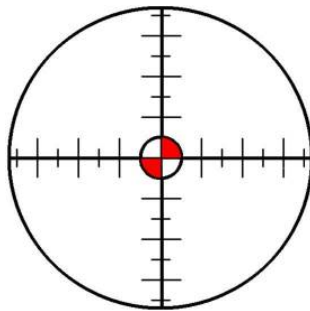

Indiana Domestic Violence Murders/Suicides

Jason Bo Compton age 20 suicide by **gun** after beating girlfriend

April Jones age 21 and Dyjuan Latendresse age 26 **shot** by Derrick Lawson (April's ex-boyfriend)

Bruce Andrews age 50 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** girlfriend Debria Andrews age 46 as she attempted to flee

Sandra Ellingsworth age 44 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** husband Timothy Ellingsworth age 58

Jessica Roberts **shot** by boyfriend

Jason Broadwater age 36 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** girlfriend Susan Moulder age 29

Eva Groves age 84 stabbed by grandson

Eugene Wells age 58 suicide by **gun** after beating girlfriend

Jamie Barker age 31 stabbed by husband

Archie Strickland age 30 and Mia Jones age 25 **shot** by Mia's husband (Archie's brother)

Louis Gonzalez age unknown **shot** by girlfriend's 13-year-old son Elijah Harris age 23 months beaten to death by parents

Shadonna Cheatham age 22 **shot** by boyfriend

Cassandra Isom age 40, Michael Moore age 16 and Ciandria Cole age 13 (Cassandra's children) **shot** by Cassandra's boyfriend

Eternity Brames age 4 months beaten to death by father Josiah Shaw age 13 months **shot** by father

Oliver Jones, Jr. suicide by **gun** after **shooting** wife (she survived)

Beverly Seavers age 48 suffocated by husband

Camdon Huffman died from premature birth after mother severely beaten by Camdon's father (Mom survived)

Amanda Brinker age 14 died from blunt force injuries to head by boyfriend

Robert Lamberson age 26 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** ex-spouse Kristina age 26 one day after being released from jail for violation of his PO

Cynthia Achenbach age 24 **shot** by husband in front of her children

Fredricka Smith age 77 **shot** by husband she had been estranged from for 30 years

Flossie Wright age 60, Demonte Norton age 10 (foster son of Flossie) and Rodney Anderson age 16 (foster son of Flossie) stabbed to death by Flossie's son Sean Wright

Scott Clark age 48 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** girlfriend Jennifer Miller age 18

Debra Furnish age 48 strangled by boyfriend

Dwayne Johnson Jr. age 28 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** daughter Jordon Johnson age 8

Stephen Johnson age 58 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** wife Renee age 49 and daughter Rebecca age 14

Jerry Brian Bobb age 33 suicide by cop (**gun**) after beating, stabbing and running over girlfriend and setting fire to apartment where their baby was (girlfriend & baby survived)

Watasha Clark age 29 **shot** by boyfriend

Brittany Alexander age 20 **shot** by roommate's boyfriend

Terry Snedekler age 39 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** wife Susan age 36 and daughter age 19

John Hood age 63 **shot** by wife as he strangled her

Laura Lewis age 59 **shot** by husband

Shane Feightner suicide by **gun** after **shooting** girlfriend Kimberly Patches age 48

Elizabeth Lepucki age 44 beaten to death by boyfriend

Tomas Solano age 30 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** wife Denise Solano age 35

Boyd Cooper age 50 suicide by **gun** after **shooting** wife Lorraine age 50

Brandi Thomas age 34 burned to death by boyfriend

Kristine Cowger age 2 months shaken to death by father

Ida Jefferson age 25 **shot** by ex-boyfriend

Jeffrey Murray age 36 suicide by **gun** after attempting to abduct girlfriend

Jessica Jones age 26 **shot** by ex-husband in front of her children

Bryan Williams age 34 suicide by cop (**gun**) after firing shotgun at officers

Erin Stanley age 19 strangled by boyfriend.

- **62 of 65 Indiana domestic violence murder/suicides were committed by males**

- **49 of 65 Indiana suicides/murders were a result of a gun**

- **16 males and 1 female committed suicide with a gun after having attempting or murdering one or more people**

- **2 women murdered their intimate partner with a gun, one while being strangled by her husband**

- **5 children under age 2 were murdered: 1 by both parents, 4 by father/boyfriend**

- **Scott County had the highest per capita rate of murder, Allen the lowest & Dubois was third highest in Indiana.**

Guns don't murder people, but pointing and firing one does.
